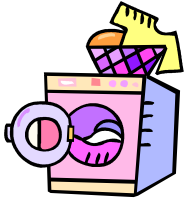

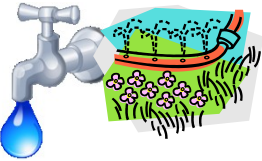

NOTICES & REMINDERS:

- **For your protection**, we do **not allow** any on-site soliciting at our sites. If someone comes to your RV to market anything – they have NOT made arrangements with us – and they should not be here!! Please let us know right away if someone approaches you who is not a resident of Somewhere RV Park!
- **On the other hand**, if residents want to trade / barter or 'work for each other' this is fine. In fact, we suggest putting notices on the bulletin boards in the buildings for things you may have for sale or want to trade/barter. This could include 'teaching something' to building something, to exchange babysitting, etc.
- **Mail & Notices:** Each resident has a designated mail box associated with your lot number. Your mail box is under the front porch of the office. Be sure to check it from time to time for 'goodies', notices, etc.
- **Current Info:** All monthly residents need to make sure we have your current phone numbers, vehicles & emergency contact information. If something has changed, please come by to update your info!
- **Needed for your file:** All monthly residents need to have a signed "Resident Rates / Policies" Form in your file. If you have not completed one (or can't remember if you did) please come by the office to take care of this ASAP!
- **Space between RV's & car noise next to bedrooms!** Please remember we designed park with 25' between each RV (your front yard). Remember NOT to park in within the 25' feet between you & your neighbor!!
- **Spring is coming – Yippie! So are varmints & bugs - Darn!** Jan has prepared a booklet for The Roost & The Bird Bath that list a bunch of Home Remedies about Fleas, Ticks, Mosquitoes, Fire Ants, etc. From time to time Jan will add other categories -- Check 'em out – they may come in handy!
